NOTIFICATION

NO.SOFT(EXT) II-20/2012. The Kheri Murat Forests of Attock Forest Division comprising of an area of 13,282 acres was declared as Reserve Forest vide Notification No. 95-F dated 01.03.1879 under Section 34 of the Indian Forest Act, 1878. An area of 3,793 acres was leased out to Pakistan Army during the year 2008 for a period of thirty (30) years, for defence purposes. The said forest area is quite adjacent to Islamabad new airport which is surrounded by various housing societies.

In exercise of the Powers conferred under subsection (1) of section 17 of the Punjab Wildlife (Protection, Preservation, Conservation and Management) Act 1974 (II of 1974), Governor of the Punjab is pleased to declare the area of Kheri Murat forests of Attock Forest Division, specified in the following Schedule as "Kheri Murat National Park" (hereinafter referred to as '**the Park**') excluding 3,793 acres leased out to Pakistan Army, with immediate effect:-

NO.SOFT(EXT)XII-1/2019. The Pabbi and Rasul Forests of Range Management Division Chakwal comprising an area of 38874 acres (38047 acres of Pabbi and 827 acres of Rasul) was declared as Reserve Forest vide Notification No. 109-F dated 06.03.1879 and 50-F dated 24.11.1879 under Section 34 of the Indian Forest Act, 1878. An area of 2500 acres situated in Compartment Nos. 61, 63, 64, 65, 66 and 69 of Pabbi Reserve Forest was leased out to Pakistan Army by Deputy Commissioner, Gujrat vide letter No. 180/CC dated 26.02.2008 for defence purposes.

2. NO. SOFT(EXT)XII-1/2020. Simbli (North) Reserved Forest is located on the Motorway (M-2) between Lilla Interchange & Kallar Kahar Interchange and easy access to the general public. It is the part of Sardhi Block of Kallar Kahar Forest Sub-Division, which comprises over 13700 acres with more than 50% vegetation cover. It comprises of dry deciduous scrub type, Phulai (acacia modesta) Kau (Olea cuspidate) and Sanatah (dodoneaviscse). In addition, it is also the natural habitat of Punjab Urial & abundant population present in the area.
