EASE OF DOING BUSINESS


- The Powers for renewal of Private Wildlife Breeding Farms were delegated at Regional level.

- Process of issuance of Inter-provincial import/export permits simplified.


PUBLIC FACILITATION

ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMUNITY BASED ORGANIZATIONS FOR PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE SPECIESTHROUGHOUT PUNJAB PROVINCE

For the protection and conservation of Punjab Urial the Department is working with the model of community participation under the provision of the Punjab



Urial, Protection, Conservation, and Trophy hunting Rules 2016 amended upto 2020.

- Community participation has played a vital role for the protection of Urial in Salt Range and a considerable number of Urial population has been increased in the area.
- For implementation of the idea of community participation in whole of the Punjab for other endangered species like Black Buck, Chinkara,



Blue Bull and Hog Deer the Department has proposed some key amendments in the aforementioned Rules.

Amendments when approved will be allow community participation model of Wildlife conservation for the whole of the Punjab and will serve as a revolutionary step towards conservation of Wildlife.

LEGISLATIVE INITIATIVES

AMENDMENTS IN EXISTING LAWS AND RULES

- Amendment in CBO Rules for more effective conservation of wildlife through community participation.
- ➤ Enhancement of penalties under provisions of Wildlife Act for effective action against illegal hunters/poachers.
- > Digitization of hunting permits (Amendments submitted).
- ➤ Placement of Brown Bear in Schedule-III of Punjab Wildlife Act giving it the status of protected specie.

NEW PROPOSED LAW / RULES

- Protected Area Act, 2019 drafted and submitted to Cabinet for approval.
- ➤ New rules proposed for Private Wildlife Parks, Private Safari Park and Private Circus.

TARGETS AND KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

SHORT TERM

- ➤ Visits of Zoo's / Wildlife Parks / Private Wildlife Breeding Farms ensuring cleanliness, visitors facilitation, exhibits health / nutrition by the concerned officers during the month.
- Offence cases registered / disposal through court and departmental compensation realized under Wildlife Act during the month.
- ➤ Different categories of licences issued / renewed during the month.
- ➤ Rate of Birth / Mortality of wildlife species at Zoo's / Wildlife Parks during the month.

- Seminars / training workshops and mass awareness activities conducted on quarterly basis.

AUSTERITY MEASURES

The Department is operating 04-Zoos and 16-Wildlife Parks in all over Punjab and working for wildlife protection and conservation in the province. Non-development budget being provided (especially the operational budget) does not cater the requirement. However, recent levy of tickets on all wildlife parks, promotion of eco-tourism and trophy hunting etc. shall lead to self sustainability and reduction in non-development budget.
